As per the Odisha ARI exam pattern, the examination is going to be held for two phases i.e. written examination and document verification. Know the details of the written exam of the OSSSC in the space below:

#### **Phrase I: Preliminary Exam (MCQ type in OMR/CBRT Mode)**

A total number of 100 questions are asked.

The written exam is conducted for 100 marks.

Marks deducted for each wrong answer is  $\frac{1}{3}$  th of the marks assigned to each question i.e 0.33 marks are deducted for each wrong answer.

The duration of the examination is  $1\frac{1}{2}$  hours.
